The PhD program at The University of Queensland's School of Education, housed within the Faculty of Social and Behavioural Sciences, is recognized for its high level of achievement in national and international academic standards. My doctoral research explored the futures of education through feminist and post-western lenses, critically examining and envisioning alternative educational paradigms and methodologies. It also marked a pioneering use of Causal Layered Analysis (CLA) methodology in the field of education, making it the first PhD to apply this innovative approach. Moreover, the Change Progression Scenario Method was conceived during the course of my doctoral research, representing a novel approach to scenario planning. This work contributed to the discipline of futures studies and to the academic discourse on social and educational change. My revised thesis was subsequently published by Tier 1 publisher Routledge, as *Educational Futures: Dominant and Contesting Visions*, (Milojević, I., 2005, republished in 2011).
